Tombolas!

What are Tombolas?

Large, zip-lock bag filled with all the things our children love. They are a huge hit with the kids at the June Fair and should be something that you would like your child to win. **Tombolas can be dropped off at the office.** Remember to label your Tombolas with your child's classroom number. JK/SK be sure to include AM or PM. The Tombola tally will be posted on the wall outside the library.

What makes up a Tombola?

Use the large zip-lock bag as the container. Almost anything goes but here are some ideas to get you started (new or gently used, good quality items only please): **CD's, DVD's, kids' books, comics, toys, arts & crafts, beads, balls, coloured pencils or pends, markers, baseball/hockey cards, marbles, skipping ropes, hair accessories, jewelry, wrapped candy, Lego...** the list is endless! Use your imagination, get your kids involved and have some fun.
